Status of NPL Men's Competition

Please be advised that the 2023 NPL NNSW Men's competition (*inclusive of both 1st & Reserve Grade*) will be operated in accordance with the [National Registration Regulations](#) as an Amateur Competition.

Whilst NNSWF intended to move towards the implementation of a professional competition in 2023, as a result of a number of internal matters in late 2022 NNSWF has opted to remain amateur. The decision to remain amateur was taken as NNSWF is of the belief that requiring clubs to comply with the Professional Windows would have been unreasonable with the proximity of the preseason window closing in early February.

To ensure clubs can plan ahead for 2024, NNSWF will confirm the status of the NPL NNSW Men's Competition by June 30th, 2023. Club education will also be in place to allow clubs to be equipped to contract players appropriately.

Please note that NNSWF is moving towards the professional model of player registration inclusive of a pre-season & mid-season transfer window. No restrictions will apply to player movements within these windows.
