Dear All,

NNSWF have commercial agreements with several media outlets across Premier Competitions and the staff who visit your venue will hold a 2023 Media Pass.

It is recognised that many clubs have their own arrangements with personnel who are considered Club Media. In order to ensure that clubs approve of and have appropriately checked any personnel who they wish to recognise as Club Media, clubs are asked to complete the following application and declaration -

[CLUB Media Accreditation](#). A separate application and declaration must be completed for each person to be recognised by your club as Club Media.

Club Media passes will be issued via the club completing the application and declaration. All clubs will be provided with a list of approved Club Media and these personnel will be required to check in with the host club when their team is away. The Club Media Accreditation will only be valid where a club's teams are playing.

In order to be approved, Club Media personnel must be registered as a volunteer to their chosen club via Play Football and as part of the application process the club must confirm the Working With Children Check has been verified. Club Media passes will not be approved for anyone who is not registered to their chosen club and it is also possible for one person to be registered as a volunteer with more than one club.
