I write to provide Premier Club Presidents with an update that applications for Round 2 of the NSW Football Legacy Fund Infrastructure Stream will be closing soon. **Applications close at 1pm on Friday 11th of August 2023.**

The NSW Football Legacy Fund aims to improve football facilities and support infrastructure, increase participation opportunities, and improve female player pathways. These improvements will create a tournament legacy ensuring all of NSW is positively impacted from hosting the 2023 FIFA Women's World Cup.

In Round 1 of the Infrastructure Grants in 2022, 5 projects across 3 zone associations were funded for a total of \$350,000. There is a possible \$667,500 in funding available to clubs and councils in northern NSW in Round 2.

Clubs and councils can apply for a minimum ask of \$25,000 and a maximum ask of \$150,000. Clubs and councils are required to provide a 50% financial co-contribution for each project. Clubs and councils can apply for up to 3 infrastructure projects with applicants asked to rank projects in order of preference to be funded.
