Following on from the launch of the Premier Youth League in 2023, the final part of the suite of competitions created is the PYL Summer Series. This part of the PYL is not a compulsory competition but provides formal weekly football during the key trial and pre-season period, and keeps your players engaged, playing football and assist with player retention.

### PYL Summer Series Key Information

- Matches to be played midweek at Lake Macquarie Regional Football Facility, to avoid both other sports on weekends and also hot weather.
- Matches will be 7 v 7, across the pitch, allowing for faster matches as well as teams who have not filled their squad as yet / have players that are unable to commit to the Summer Series.
- Matches will be 2 x 20 minute halves.
- Leagues will be offered for 2023's under 12s through to under 16s.
- Players will only need to be registered with a Northern NSW Football club, allowing new players who join your club to play in the Summer Series.
- The competition will run from the week starting October 9<sup>th</sup> through to the last week in November.
- Clubs can choose which age groups to enter teams in. 1 team max per age group.
- The team entry fee for each team will be \$250 which includes all venue hire, staffing and referees' fees.
- The PYL Summer Series is available for both boys and girls.

Dependent on the number of entries in each age group, we may be able to split into divisions to keep the football even more competitive. This competition is designed to be a less formal form of football which still provides access to competitive football throughout the off-season and allows clubs to keep players engaged and improving throughout October and November.

Newcastle Jets Academy may also be involved with consideration given to playing them in the most appropriate age groups.
