Dear All,

Unfortunately, as has been the case for much of the 2025 season, wet weather will again affect the conclusion of the Premier Youth League (Boys & Girls) seasons.

To ensure clarity and fairness, the Points Per Game (PPG) method will be applied to final standings as follows:

PYL Boys

- All matches completed on or before this coming Sunday 17th August will count towards the PPG calculation.
- PPG will then be used to finalise the standings and determine match pairings for:
 - Semi-final first legs.
 - 5th v 6th placing matches.
 - 7th v 8th placing matches.
- While we have received requests to play matches after this date, the likelihood of further rain early next week — combined with the importance of confirming match locations with all teams by Monday — means we will not schedule matches beyond this Sunday.
- If you are able to work with opposition to get further games played over the next few days — please get in touch with us and let us know the proposal.

PYL Girls

- As previously proposed to clubs, an extra week will be added to the competition.
- This means PPG may still be required, but the last date for matches for PYLG will be Sunday 24th August.
- The Football Operations Team will work to scheduled matches over the next 24 hours for next weekend and possibly midweek.
- This will mean that the PYL Girls grand final will move from Friday 5th September to Saturday 13th September.



PPG will be added to all league tables to ensure transparency and assist clubs in understanding their potential position.

We thank all clubs, players, and officials for their patience and understanding during another challenging wet weather season.

All Week 1 Finals fixtures will be released by the Monday following the last eligible match date for each competition.

Thank you for your cooperation as we work to conclude the season fairly and with as much notice to participants as possible.
