Reportable Incidents

For matches which are on Squadi, Send Off Reports and Incident Reports are to be submitted via Squadi in the first instance. If a NNSWF-sanctioned match is not on Squadi (trial matches, Australia Cup matches etc.), the following forms should be completed for reportable incidents. If the match is sanctioned by FNSW, incidents are to be reported through Dribl. NNSWF may also request that subsequently to completing a report on Squadi an additional report from the links below be completed.
