



Coaching Positions - Talented Player Pathway (Casual)

Northern NSW Football (NNSWF) is the peak body charged by Football Federation Australia with the responsibility of growing, developing and promoting the sport of Football throughout Northern NSW and is one of the largest State Sporting Organisations (SSO's) in NSW.

NNSWF are currently seeking to appoint a set of experienced and accredited coaches to implement the training and development of NNSWF players within Talented Player programs.

Talent Support Program (TSP)

NNSWF implements the Talent Support Program (TSP) for identified players within NNSWF's Premier Competitions.

The TSP underpins the Jets Academy and provides high level training and competition for players with potential to transition into the Jets Academy in future years.

The TSP train exclusively at the LMRFF with squads playing identified elite matches against other Member Federations and A-League Academies throughout the year.

The program consists of 1 training session per week for 30 weeks throughout the season with a games schedule in addition.

Emerging Jets (Girls)

NNSWF implements the Emerging Jets (EJ's) for identified girls in the skill acquisition phase.

The Emerging Jets underpins the Jets Academy and provides high level training and competition for girls with potential to transition into the Jets Academy in future years. The Emerging Jets train exclusively at the LMRFF with squads playing an age group down in the Premier Club SAP (Boys) leagues.

The program consists of 3 sessions per week for 40 weeks throughout the season with a match each weekend.

The successful applicants will have a strong background in Youth Development, a desire to maximise the potential of identified players and a commitment to ensuring the best possible learning environment for each individual player.

Key tasks include:

- Provide a safe and positive environment for all players throughout the duration of the program;
- Developing and enhancing all players love of the game;
- Developing and enhancing all players football behaviors, technical ability and understanding of the game;
- Creating and delivering session plans based on the four core skills aligning to the periodised plan provided by the Technical Director;
- Preparing and managing the team on identified match days throughout the year;
- Completing player reports when requested by the Technical Director; and
- Assisting with the identification of players within and external to the programs

Employment Conditions and Remuneration Package

This role is being offered on a casual basis. Remuneration will be aligned to Coach grade 1 of the Sporting Organisations Award (2010) at \$32.21 per hour plus superannuation if applicable. The nature of this position will require significant evening and weekend working hours.
