



## **SAP Technical Advisor (Boys) (Casual or Part Time)**

Northern NSW Football (NNSWF) is the peak body charged by Football Australia with the responsibility of growing, developing, and promoting the sport of Football throughout Northern NSW. With over 65,000 registered players throughout our region, NNSWF is one of the largest State Sporting Organisations (SSO's) in NSW.

NNSWF seeks to appoint a suitably qualified and experienced SAP Technical Advisor (Boys) to join the Member Federations team of technical experts and deliver the suite of assessment, support, development, and player identification activities aligned to the Skill Acquisition Phase and specifically the NNSWF Junior Development League (JDL).

The SAP Technical Advisor is charged with the responsibility of assisting Clubs competing in the JDL to improve the overall capacity to deliver high quality learning environments for their players and coaches.

### **Key areas of responsibility include:**

- The planning, delivery and evaluation of NNSWF's centralised JDL training assessment program.
- Deliver formal JDL match assessments.
- Assist in the implementation of the suite of JDL regional gala days.
- Provide both formal and informal mentoring, education, development and support for registered JDL coaches.
- Identify potentially talented players and coaches within the JDL through NNSWF's centralised, State-wide Talent ID Portal.
- Assist in the planning and delivery of TSP trials as required.
- In conjunction with Coach Education Co-ordinator, facilitate, and in some cases deliver professional development and support to JDL club Technical Directors and coaches; and
- Provide advice and make recommendations as required to the Head of Football Development.



### **Employment Conditions and Remuneration Package**
