### PURPOSE OF ROLE

The SAP Technical Advisor will deliver the suite of assessment, support, development and player identification activities associated within NNSWF's Junior Development League (JDL).

The SAP Technical Advisor is charged with the responsibility of improving the overall capacity of clubs competing in the JDL to deliver quality learning environments for their players and coaches.

### KEY AREAS OF RESPONSIBILITY

- The planning, delivery and evaluation of NNSWF's centralised JDL training assessment program.
- Deliver formal JDL match assessments.
- Assist in the implementation of the suite of JDL regional gala days.
- Provide both formal and informal mentoring, education, development and support for registered JDL coaches.
- Identify potentially talented players and coaches within the JDL through NNSWF's centralised, State-wide Talent ID Portal.
- Assist in the planning and delivery of TSP trials as required.
- In conjunction with Coach Education Co-ordinator, facilitate, and in some cases deliver professional development and support to JDL club Technical Directors and coaches; and
- Provide advice and make recommendations as required to the Head of Football Development.

**KEY OUTCOMES**

- Improve the capacity of clubs competing in the JDL to deliver quality learning environments.
- Improved the technical proficiency of players and coaches and technical directors engaged in the JDL.
- Identify players participating in SAP age groups that have potential to progress through the Talented Player Pathway; and
- Assist NNSWF and the Newcastle Jets to transition players from the JDL or NNSWF's TSPs to the Newcastle Jets Academy.

- Excellent understanding of the Junior development League and Regional JDL Gala Day structures.

- Demonstrated experience delivering professional development for coaches engaged in the skill acquisition phase; and
- Ability to work effectively and collaboratively with technical directors, coaches, administrators and players with discretion, good judgement, understanding and diplomacy.
