MSP MiniRoos Coach

Overview

The MSP MiniRoos Coach is responsible for the delivery of MiniRoos Multicultural Settlement Program (MSP) training sessions, to ensure all participants have fun, make new friends and develop new skills in an inclusive environment.

Key Responsibilities

1. Deliver all MiniRoos sessions in an engaging and fun way for all participants.
2. Liaise with the NNSWF Programs Coordinator to complete a Grassroots Coaching Course.
3. Inspect and ensure all training/playing fields are safe and fit to play.
4. Ensure all required equipment is accessible and ready for use prior to the session.
5. Ensure smooth running of MiniRoos training/matches and encourage participants in a positive and fun way.
6. Liaise with MiniRoos Hub Coordinator and ensure pitch allocation/playing times are adhered to in an organised manner.
7. Arrange the set up and packing up of all equipment after sessions are completed.

Essential Skills and requirements

- Hold or willing to apply for a current paid “Working With Children Check” (of over the age of 18)
- Be fully vaccinated
- Experience working with children from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds (desirable)
- MiniRoos Grassroots Coaching Certificate (desirable)
- Good organisation skills
- Great communicator with effective mediation and negotiation skills
- Able to prioritise and delegate tasks.
- Positive attitude and enthusiastic demeanor.
- Passionate about junior football.

The estimated time commitment required as the MiniRoos Game Leader is 1-2 hours per week.
